

Initial phase of treatment:

2 initial activations are made in the office that the orthodontist does.

Subsequently, the activation must be done by an adult who will receive the instructions as it should be done.

- For 8 days it will be activated once in the morning and once at night during this period, and will return to the office to show the expansion, it is normal that there is a diastema (space) between the central teeth, this will indicate that the device has started its expansive effect and it will close spontaneously.
- Maintenance and control phase:  
Control appointments will be made in order to review the need to increase expansion, handling hygiene and care with the device.
- Once the planned objectives have been achieved, the same device will be retained and another lower expansion device that performs the same expansive effect on the lower jaw that performs the same expansive effect on the lower jaw will be placed and thus give room for eruption (exit) of permanent teeth.

APPROXIMATE TIME OF TREATMENT IS 12 MONTHS, WHICH WILL GO ACCORDING TO THE NEEDS OF THE CASE AND THE PATIENT'S COLLABORATION WITH THE TREATMENT.
